Prospective authors must adhere to the following guidelines: (1) article length is 10 pages minimum and 15 pages maximum, including bibliography and appendices; (2) abstract and its key words are included; (3) the article may be written by three persons maximum with a photograph of its attached; and (4) attach a bio mentioning author's current profession, postal, and e-mail addresses.

The article should follow the outline:

Title (brief, clear, and interesting)

Name of author

Abstract

Introduction

Subtitle

Closing (conclusion and recommendation)

References (contains literature cites in the text)

Internet sources should include place and date of access.

The article should be sent at least 3 (three) months prior to the publication months (March and November) addressed to the editor of APLINESIA. It is recommended that the article e sent via e-mail. E-mail addresses that can be contacted are: aplinesia@ump.ac.id
